



***Good Housekeeping* Award for Women in Government**  
and  
***Good Housekeeping/Wyeth* Award for Women's Health**

★ **Help us find our eight award winners for 2005!**

Any woman in government – elected or appointed, career civil servant or member of the armed services, serving in federal, state or local government – is eligible. Nominees may be recommended for a specific achievement, program, or project or for a career which demonstrates how women in government can change our lives for the better. (Read about past winners at [www.cawp.rutgers.edu](http://www.cawp.rutgers.edu).)

A selection panel of distinguished leaders will judge the nominations, with *Good Housekeeping* selecting the final winners of **one award of \$25,000 and six awards of \$2,500 each**. In addition, the ***Good Housekeeping/Wyeth Award for Women's Health*** carries an award of **\$25,000** for a woman in government whose program or achievement advances the status of women's health. Nominees whose work addresses women's health will automatically be considered for both the Wyeth Award and the *Good Housekeeping* Awards.

★ Winners will be announced in the July issue of the magazine, available in June 2005. Nominees will not be notified directly unless chosen to receive an award. Nominators will be advised in late spring if their nominees have not been selected.

- Completed nomination form.
- Nomination essay of no more than three pages, showing how nominee's achievement fits the criteria listed on the form.
- Mailed materials attached with staples or paper clips only; **please do not use folders or binders**. No video or audiotapes, books, or computer disks.
- Completed nominations must be postmarked, emailed or faxed **no later than December 6, 2004**. Incomplete nominations will not be considered.
- Confirmation that your nomination packet has been received:
  - For mailed nominations, enclose a self-addressed, stamped postcard that we can return to you.
  - For emailed nominations, acknowledgment will be sent back to your email address.
  - For faxed nominations, include an email address on the fax cover sheet to receive a confirmation.

Do not submit video or audiotapes, books, or computer disks.

**Do not use any folder or binding other than staples or paper clips.**

No materials supplied to support the entry will be returned.
